He also added that we should also motivate others to keep their environment clean and free of pollution so that we can live a healthy life.


It was the pleasurable activity we enjoyed most and promised to plant more trees in our surroundings.



ENGLISH LITERARY WEEK-READ ALOUD COMPETITION


Day & Date: 14th JUNE TO 19TH JUNE
