6-8	<p>NO PLASTIC, GO GREEN “Waste isn't waste until we waste it, instead use it diligently”</p> <p><u>Challenge for FN:</u> Plastic bags often end up polluting our oceans and endangering wildlife. Design a reusable way to carry shopping. Grade	Challenge
9-12	<p>TCS GLOW GARDEN Students have to design a glow garden using reused plastic bottles, spoons, jars and electrical lights to decorate different areas in the school. (E.g. Library, Garden, Reception)</p> <p><u>Challenge for AN:</u> Design innovative display items for the Glow Garden using their engineering skills.</p> <p><u>Challenge for FN:</u> Use the Glow items and interior designing skills to decorate different areas in school.</p>
