Greetings from The Central School Dubai!

April 18 was identified as the World Heritage Day in the year 1982 by International Council for Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS). It was suggested that a special day should be marked and celebrated all through the world in the name of "International Day for Monuments and Sites". This special day offers an opportunity to raise the public's awareness about the diversity of cultural heritage and the efforts that are required to protect and conserve it, as well as draw attention to its vulnerability.

To raise awareness about the diversity of cultural heritage and to inspire the future generations, World Heritage Day will be celebrated at The Central School on Monday, 18th April 2022. By celebrating this day, the students will be able to explain the concept of World Heritage and importance of the cultural heritages and preserving it with pride for future.

A plethora of activities are organized to mark the importance of this day which are as follows:

Grade	Activity	Description
KG 1	Across the Globe	Students will be dressed in the attire of the country they are representing and design the flag.
KG 2	Across the Globe	Students will be dressed in the attire of the country they will represent and speak about the culture of that country. Students will make a passport and paste the flag of different countries in it.
Grade 1 and 2	Across the Globe	Students will take virtual tours of countries in order to recognize and celebrate tangible and intangible heritage across cultures and borders. Teachers will give students thinking routines or organizers so that they can design their own learning experiences. Students are requested to dress up as per the culture of the country they've chosen or bring any artifacts to display in class.



Grade 3	Model Making	Students will explore landmarks of UAE in order to develop models and refurbish them in order to preserve UAE culture and heritage.
Grade 4 and 5	Power Point Presentations	Students will create the PowerPoint presentations to embark the importance of heritage while connecting to the SDG Goals.
Grade 6	Traditional Native Tales/ Classical Stories/ Fables	Students will display old traditional stories and create a brand-new ending with a moral. They can display it in form of a PPT or a word document, they can choose to write and illustrate it with picture as per their choice.
Grade 7	My Encyclopedia Catalogue	Students will create an album to display the entire information for a city or place culture. They can stick colorful pictures, stick, maps, monuments, food, dress, festivals and illustrate giving information to the reader about a city, place which will work like a guide for visitors.
Grade 8	Travelicious Students Video Making/ Film Making/	Students in groups will choose a country and they will match the game played in that country. Briefing about the game and the history behind it will be shared by the students. Talk on the national players with the message about the game will be conveyed.
Grade 9	Local Pride	Students will have an information desk to display about the heritage, culture, and future of UAE. Class students as a team will create a counter to display information about the county (UAE) they are living in.
