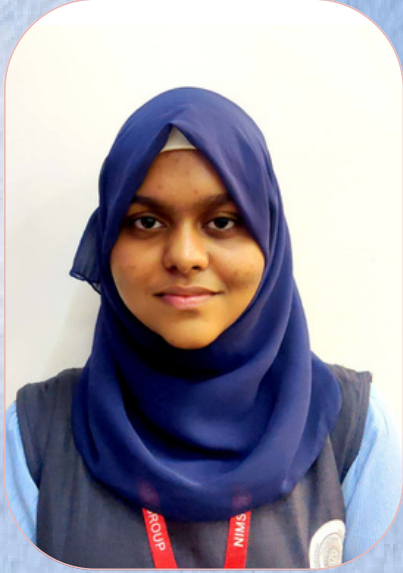
Literacy Program - Educational Field Trip
