Teaching kids to count is fine, but teaching them what counts is best” – Bob Talbert

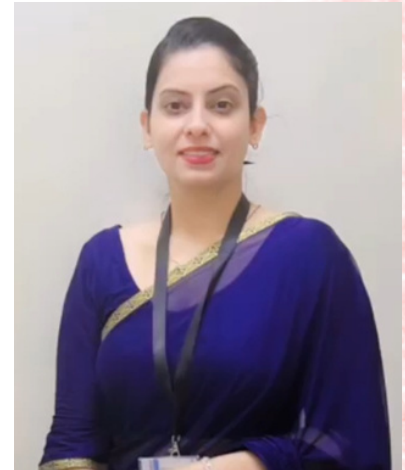
Dear Parents,

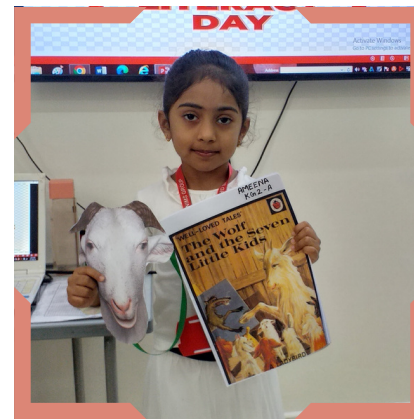




EVENTS AT GLANCE

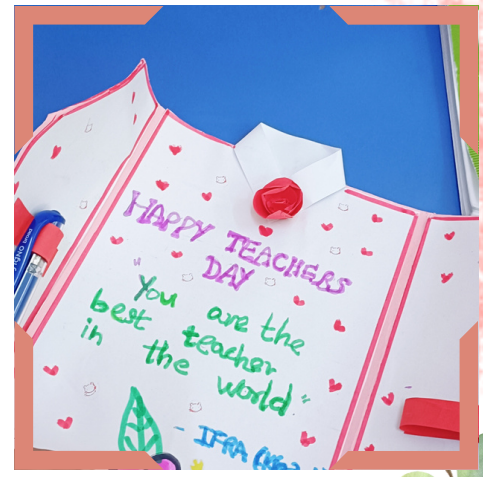
KG2 : VEGETABLE SALAD DAY

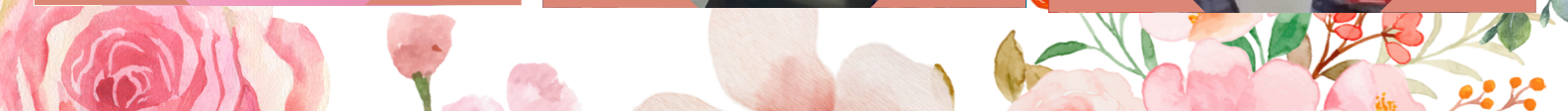


KG2 : EDUTAINMENT TRIP: KIDZANIA
