SUBJECT: STUDENT SAFETY AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

Dear Parents,

Greetings from The Central School, Dubai!

As part of our ongoing commitment to student safety and community responsibility, we would like to bring to your attention pressing concerns that require immediate cooperation and action.

1. Use of E-Scooters and bicycles by Students

It has come to our notice that a growing number of students commute to school using e-scooters and bicycles often accompanied by younger siblings. While we appreciate efforts to promote independence and eco-friendly transport, this practice has become increasingly hazardous due to

- High speed, high traffic volume around the school premises during peak hours
- Careless riding, racing, and disregard for road safety
- Frequent falls and near-miss incidents with moving vehicles

We urge all parents to closely monitor their children's mode of transport and discourage the use of bicycles and e-scooters for school commutes. The school cannot assume responsibility for any mishap arising from such practices. Prevention is always better than cure—let us work together to ensure our children's safety.

2. Traffic Violations During Arrival and Dispersal

We are also concerned about traffic violations occurring during drop-off and pick-up times, specifically:

- Double parking in front of the school gate, which is strictly prohibited by government authorities
- Unsafe U-turns made directly in front of the school for convenience, disrupting traffic flow from opposite side and endangering students.

These actions compromise the safety of all children and create unnecessary congestion. We humbly request all parents to adhere to traffic rules and cooperate with school staff and security personnel during these critical times. You are hereby requested to collect your children by parking your car in the designated parking area.
